# Impact Survey Report

May 2019




### Overview

- The survey was conducted during the period of 30<sup>th</sup> March until 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019. It was sent out to 3,840 learners and received 408 responses; it corresponds to 10,6%.
- The survey was available in four languages English, Spanish, French and Portuguese.
- 52% of respondents are male and 46% are female.
- 58% of respondents are from Latin America and the Caribbean; 22% are from Africa; 12% from Asia; 1% from North America and 0,7% from Oceania.
- In relation to affiliation, 36% of respondents are from academia or university, 22% of respondents
  are from the private sector and 17% of respondents are from the government at national,
  provincial or local level.
- 83% of respondents have applied or used the knowledge from our courses.
- 63% of respondents have applied the knowledge or skills at work frequently.
- 41% of respondents recognized the importance of knowledge/skill to their job success.
- 23% of respondents have used the knowledge/skill from the course to produce new content or to develop a project in a related area.
- 60% of respondents have either their job or social status improved as a result of taking UN CC:Learn course.
- 61% of respondents have enrolled in a course because of a professional interest either to grow on their current job or in another job.
- 66% of respondents have been involved in climate change activities after taking UN CC:Learn course.
- 97% of respondents have changed their resources consumption patter to some extent.
- 26% of respondents had their perspective changed as a result of taking UN CC:Learn course.
- 43% of respondents would not donate to make the course available to more people and 40% would donate \$10 or less.


### Results

### 1. What is your gender?




• 46% of respondents are female, 53% are male and 0,5% preferred not to say.

### 2. What is your country of origin?




- 58% of respondents are from Latin America and the Caribbean;

### 3. Which is your professional affiliation?




- 36% of respondents are from academia or university.

### 4. When did you most recently take a course?




• 49% of respondents took UN CC: Learn courses in 2018; 21% took our courses in 2017 and 15% took our courses in 2019.

### 5. Why did you primarily enrol in this course?




- 61% of respondents have enrolled in a course because of a professional interest either to grow on their current job or in another job.
- 36% of respondents have enrolled in a course because of a personal interest.

### 6. Have you applied/used the acquired knowledge from the course?




• 83% of respondents have applied or used the knowledge from our courses.

### 7. Which factors have prevented you from applying the knowledge/skills?




- 56% of respondents didn't have the opportunity to apply the knowledge/skill.
- 12% of respondents didn't apply the knowledge/skill due to the lack of time.
- 10% of respondents didn't apply the knowledge/skill due to either the lack of support from supervisor or systems and processes.
- 6% of respondents didn't apply the knowledge/skill due to the lack of funds.

- 63% of respondents have applied the knowledge or skills at work frequently.
- 32% of respondents have applied the knowledge or skills at work occasionally.
- 4% of respondents have almost never applied the knowledge or skills at work.

- 41% of respondents had confidence to apply the knowledge/skill
- 41% of respondents recognized the importance of knowledge/skill to their job success.

'At the moment, we are developing Climate Change Action Plan and Climate Change Policy for Kenya. I have been able to apply concept learnt in REDD+ courses while Filling in forms for grants to donors willing to support the process'.

'I work at the University of San Carlos in Guatemala as an assistant professor in the area of Microbiology. The knowledge acquired in the course serves to relate bacterial growth with climate or climatic conditions, as well as other relevant topics of interest in the Biological Chemistry career.'

'Became part of the climate and environmental department at my current place of work to formulate a deliberate policy in the organisation to ensure that whatever we are doing as a company, we are protecting the environment'.

'As a translator, knowing more about the UNFCCC process has helped me to have a better understanding of documents.'


'Have applied the skill by teaching my students about the effect of climate change and orientated them about the effect of human actions that trigger the effect and how they could curtail it'.


'I have used the skills and knowledge I gained to train bachelor students and to undertake research.'

### 11. As a follow-up to the course, what specific actions or measures have you taken?




- 26% of respondents had their perspective changed as a result of taking UN CC:Learn course.
- 23% of respondents have used the knowledge/skill from the course to produce new content or to develop a project in a related area.
- 17% of respondents changed the way of they do an aspect of their work as a result of taking UN CC:Learn course.
- 8% of respondents have receive recognition in their word as a result of taking UN CC:Learn course.
- 2% of respondents made UN CC:Learn course mandatory to their employees.

### 12. Have you been involved in climate change related activities since taking the course?




• 66% of respondents have been involved in climate change activities after taking UN CC:Learn course.

### 13. Which of the following did the course help you improve?




- 60% of respondents have either their job or social status improved as a result of taking UN CC:Learn course.

'Before the budgets of environmental mitigation measures in irrigation projects were made by an external consultant, now with the knowledge acquired in the courses I took, I can do them myself.'


'The knowledge from the course helped me with my work when preparing project description, etc.'

'I just acquired the skills that were needed in for the position I have now at my current work place.'


'I now fully understand what climate change is and how best I can promote the conservation of climate and the environment.'
